Clinic Content: The Introduction to “Officiating” Clinic is an entry-level training clinic, designed to introduce new officials to the Rules of Tennis, the Code of Conduct, and the basic techniques of officiating. It is also recommended for officials who have not been active in the past two years, or who would like a refresher of rules, regulations and procedures.
