2009 Outdoor Junior National Qualifier Eligibility

The 2009 Tennis Saskatchewan Outdoor Junior National Qualifier will be held on May 29 – 31, 2009. The Qualifier will be held in Saskatoon, exact location is TBA. Participants wishing to qualify for Junior Nationals must qualify through the Outdoor Junior National Qualifying process.

Tennis Saskatchewan will have 2 spots / event / gender for all Junior National Events (Under 12, Under 14, Under 16, Under 18).

Eligibility for the 2009 Outdoor Junior National Qualifier will be based on the following criteria:

1. All athletes must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents.
2. All athletes must maintain a permanent residence in the province of Saskatchewan as evidenced by a valid Saskatchewan Health Services Card. Students attending school out of province are eligible to participate, however they must still meet the above mentioned residence criteria.
3. All athletes must be in good standing with Tennis Saskatchewan (i.e. financial, discipline, etc.)
4. **All athletes must participate in a minimum of two tournaments “sanctioned” by a Provincial, State, and/or National Tennis Association, provided one of these tournaments is a Saskatchewan Sanctioned Junior Open Tournament, within the 2 months immediately preceding the date of the applicable qualifying event (March 29 – May 28, 2009).**

Some examples of eligible tournaments include (other tournaments may be eligible):

Open Tournaments (in province or out of province)
Junior Open Tournaments (in province or out of province)
5.5, 5.0, 4.5, 4.0, 3.5 Tournaments (in province or out of province)

Ineligible tournaments include all Rookie Tour and Team Tennis Tournaments. Indoor and/or Outdoor Junior Nationals will not be considered as eligible tournaments.

Appeals, based on extenuating circumstances, must be received in writing, by May 22, 2009. Written appeals must be forwarded to Tennis Saskatchewan, 2205 Victoria Avenue, Regina, SK S4P 0S4.
