He has also worked as a Chair Umpire and Referee in various Davis Cup ties, Fed Cup ties, Asian Games, Universiade Games etc. He is now working full time traveling to tennis tournaments in Asia and Canada.

**Clinic Content:** The Introduction to “Officiating” Clinic is the entry-level training clinic, designed for beginner to novice officials. The objective of the clinic is to introduce new officials to the Rules of Tennis, the Code of Conduct, and the basic techniques of officiating.
